


Game Boy Color Adobe Ilustrator, 2015

Here is a cleaned-up illustration of the Game Boy Color from my and my younger brother's youth overlayed on the original sketches for it. Here, you can see some of the original damage in the two remaining sketches, and arrows labeling where damage has been removed from the final illustration to appear new again.



Girl's Room Adobe Ilustrator, 2015

Using the bellow image as reference, I created a vector of the room using a complementary color scheme of tints of red (pink) and green to shade the previously white sections. This was done almost entirely by employing the pen tool to create shapes.

Lou's Place Webpage Redesign Adobe Illustrator, 2015



Since it is well-reviewed but little known, I included Google Reviews and social media buttons for coupons and offers. I used calm colors of pastel blue and light violet, as well as a red heart to balance the top and bottom of the page. The bandages are autotraced from stock in limited colors.



Omnomnom Snail Totem

A playful ellaboration of an early traditional media piece, the human character, representing myself, lays tired with her shell used for safety and comfort from the stressful world. She has a small neutral snail on top of her and both of them sit on top of a large neutral snail. Behind them radiating out is dewy green grass and white dandelion puffs shaded in green, making the mostly pink character pop out visually due to the complementary color scheme.



In Desperation Corel Painter 2015

An illustration to the song "Housewife Radio" this piece is one of four variations. The colors include only that which are listed in the song. The background is tiled with the figure's bleeding eyes, and the foreground has white static made with Real Long Bristol - Acrylic with the shapes of the words "BLACK AND WHITE" cut out of them. Her torso is a vintage radio with speakers in shapes of hearts, above which is the phrase "help me" written minisculey in white.



Decorative Altoids Tin

Corel Painter 2015

This is a still life study of a decorative Altoids mints tin in an analogous warm color scheme. It is made using a variety of digital markers, mainly the Blunt Tip and the Art Marker. When applying generous pressure to the Blunt Tip while using red, it appeared to become an off-magenta, despite actually being red, which defines it well from the pure red of the lid.



Untitled Still Life P1V4

Corel Painter 2015

Here is another still life study with more emphasis on composition and texture using a complementary color scheme of varying tints, tinted shades, and shades of red (pink) and green. The objects include a lunch bag, scarf, art box, and 3Ds cover to elevate the scarf. It is rendered mostly with Wet Acrylic, highlighted with the digital airbrush, and textured with the Texturize-Fine (art box) and Course Impasto Jitter (scarf) from the Impasto brushes.
