



Online Student Hour Instructions

How to reach Professor Hokerson

Each week I am available for one hour online, as posted in the class Syllabus. During this hour I can be reached through an app called Line (<http://line.me>) which provides a free platform to:

- Text Message (via SMS)
- Group Chat
- Audio and Video Message
- Voice Call



Here are some general steps you'll need to access me during my scheduled online student hour:

1. Download the free app which is available across many platforms:

Mobile accessibility: Android, Blackberry IOS, Nokia, Windows Phone

Desktop accessibility: Windows and Mac OS X

2. Create an account, using either your phone number and/or email.
3. Verify your account

My username is: professor_hokerson.

The first time you contact me, be sure to include your full name (the one you are registered under) and the course you are enrolled in (e.g. Psyc 300, Human Sexuality, Diversity, etc.) so that I can add you to my “Friend” list and make connecting easier.

Rules and Expectations

1. I will only answer *Line* voice calls during my scheduled student hour; I will not answer any other time.
2. Feel free to text me anytime, although email will still be my primary (and preferred) point of written contact during the week.
 - a. Anything that you want written proof of should be communicated through email.
3. Use proper English writing standards, as I am not well versed on texting lingo 😊
4. If you leave me an audio message I will get back to you within a couple of days, excluding weekends.
