

Spanish Hybrid FAQ's



Q: *What does “hybrid” mean?*

A: Hybrid means that part of the course is delivered online and part is delivered in the classroom.

Q: *Do I have to do less or more work than a regular (non-hybrid) Spanish class?*

A: This class covers the same amount of material as a regular face-to-face class. So even though part of the content is delivered online, you are still responsible for completing the same assignments.

Q: *How often do I have to come to campus?*

A: For this class, you are required to attend class in Davies Hall **one** day a week. Since you are also required to complete online assignments, both individually and with a partner, you may also take advantage of the computers available in the Foreign Language Lab in the [Learning Resource Center \(LRC\)](#). See [ARC campus map](#).

Q: *How computer savvy do I need to be?*

A: You need to have basic web-navigation, word-processing, and email skills. Familiarity with PowerPoint will be helpful. You should also approach this class with an open-minded attitude, willing to learn how to use electronic (online) text book materials.

Q: *Do I have to use my own computer?*

A: No, you are welcome to use the computers in the Foreign Language Lab. See the schedule below for drop-in times. If you choose to use a computer off-campus, keep in mind the following technical requirements:

Operating System: Microsoft Windows 98, NT, 2000, ME, XP or Mac OS X

CPU: 233MHz

RAM: 128MB

Screen resolution: 1024 x 768 or higher

Browser: PC: [Internet Explorer 6.x](#) or higher, or [Firefox](#) version 1.x or later. Mac: [Firefox](#) version 1.x or later, or [Safari](#) (provided with OS X).

Network Connection: A high-speed connection with throughput of 256 Kbps or more is recommended to use audio and video components.

Equipment: You will need speakers or a headset to listen to audio and video components, and a microphone is necessary for recording activities.
